content

1. Text matter of a document or publication in any form. Content is both information and communication: the sum total of the freshness, readability, relevancy, and usefulness of the information presented, and the manner in which it is presented.
2. Essence of a communicated message or discourse, as comprehended or received by its intended audience.

USAGE EXAMPLE

There wasn't much **content** in the students term paper, it was mostly just filler and fluff, and definitely didn't impress the professor.

algorithm

Step by step procedure designed to perform an operation and which (like a map or flowchart) will lead to the sought result if followed correctly. Algorithms have a definite beginning and a definite end, and a finite number of steps. An algorithm produces the same output information given the same input information, and several short algorithms can be combined to perform complex tasks.

USAGE EXAMPLE

The scientists required an **algorithm** that would allow them to figure out the problem in an orderly, numerical and precise manner, resulting in a conclusive answer.
